TRILOK COVID PROTOCOLS

Please keep in mind that these protocols are subject to change

GENERAL PROTOCOL

- Mask mandate: Children 2-4 are still required to wear a mask. Children 5 and up are no longer required to wear masks.
- Staff: Vaccine and boosters are mandatory
- Eligible students: Vaccine is strongly recommended
- Following CDC protocols, if there is a positive case in a classroom, the class will be notified and will be asked to get tested before returning to school. Students in class will be tested again three days after initial exposure.
- Student(s) who test positive:
- Unvaccinated: must quarantine for 10 days and send in a negative PCR test before returning to school
- Vaccinated: must quarantine for at least 5 days and send in a negative PCR test before returning to school

GENERAL PROTOCOL CONT...

- Temperature check and sanitization at drop off and dismissal every day
- Health check form filled out every morning before arrival at school
- Air filters in every classroom and throughout the building
- Surfaces are sanitized everyday
- Extra masks are available always in each classroom and at the front desk

GENERAL PROTOCOL CONT...

- If a family member at home tests positive, we will inform the class and will ask the class parents to get all students in the class tested before returning to school the next day.
- If child of positive parent tests negative and can isolate from the positive person, then they may return to school. If not, then we ask them to quarantine for 10 days.
- Trilok has rapid tests in case of emergencies.

TRAVEL PROTOCOLS

- If anyone travels out of state or country, we require a negative PCR before returning to school
- For those traveling in NY state, we require either a negative rapid or PCR before returning to school
- Results must be sent to the front desk PRIOR to coming into the school building
- If you are <u>not fully vaccinated</u> and are traveling, according to CDC guidelines, "get tested with a viral test 3-5 days after returning from travel. Stay home and self-quarantine for a full 7 days after travel, even if you test negative at 3-5 days"
